VIRGIN MONEY, MAKE £5 GROW SCHEME



In early January, Class 2 were visited by 2 representatives from Virgin Money to introduce them to the 'Make £5 Grow Scheme'. The idea is to give school children real life experience of starting a mini business.

It's great fun, they learn lots, and it helps them build skills for the future. What's more it gets them thinking like entrepreneurs!

Virgin Money will lend school £5 for each pupil taking part, for us this will be £60.

Once the decision has been made the hard work begins!
